PROVISIONAL ADMISSION PROCESS FOR NON -JAIN PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

- All the students who have appeared and successfully cleared CBSE/ICSE/State board class IX examination of their respective schools are eligible to apply for the provisional admission to grade XI
- Admission shall be given based on Grade X first term report card and performance in the entrance exams followed by interview with the admission committee.
- Admission given shall be provisional; it will be confirmed if the child meets the eligibility criteria and successfully clears board Xth examination.

Process

- Collect the stream selection form and admission form from the school office or you may download from website
- Stream selection and admission form duly filled along with following documents to be submitted to the school office
 - Grade X first term marksheet
 - Birth certificate copy
 - Aadhar card copy
 - Three passport size photos

- After verifying the documents the dates of entrance exam, stream counseling session shall be shared.
- The fees has to be paid immediately once the result is declared to block the seats
- Books and notebooks can be collected from the school office in lieu of fee receipt
- The uniform can be collected from the address as provided below

Documents to be submitted for confirmation of admission

- **Mark sheet of class X board exam (photocopy – self attested)**
- **Original Transfer or school leaving certificate**
- **Migration certificate in case students coming from boards other than CBSE**
- The new academic session starts from 5th June 2020

ADMISSION PROCESS FOR JAIN PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Parents are required to select the choice of stream and subjects by ticking the box given above
- Duly filled choice of stream and subject form signed by parents to be submitted to school office by 19th February 2020
- Fees for the academic session should be paid between 1st March 2020 to 15th March 2020.
- Books and notebooks can be collected in lieu of the fee receipt between 15th March to 30th March
- ID card data shall be checked at the time of issuance of books & notebooks. No change shall be made post that.
- House uniform as per the house allotted last year along with the school uniform can be collected from Vendors shop directly.
