Hey Mates! It has been a long time since I shared about a tragic incident of my life, My loss of memory at the age of 11. Pursuing the past with what I had stopped with. "Unlike any other person, I was seen surprisingly calm and comprehending to the current situation of my adoption. When I walked out all I received was just glistening glares of grief from my friends at the orphanage. It had just been a month since I woke up, the world seemed new to me, it wasn't for me to make friends, but the way the care-takers and the wardenlllll was insane. The nearby lands and the infrastructure infrastructure of the building itself seemed serene. But the vibe it gave away was just terrorizing". " Do not drink water too much before sleep!", "Just Five minutes for using the loo.," " Wash your clothes daily! "," Wake up at four "," Just four pair of clothes for each kid!"," Porridge for breakfast, one glass per head "," No chit-chatting with peers!", they always repeat the same instructions over and over again, no matter whether if it is being followed or not. If we missed to act perfect, we were asked to come to the management and were given additional chores which lasted till midnight. Upon seeing and feeling all these my self my heartached for justice. Out of rage, we set up a gathering at the lucky hour behind zara's large, cozy bed, the mayor's daughter who had been sent her due to his second marriage, done for increasing popularity and publicity among the people of the city. We planned of escaping in the same hour three days after. But unfortunately someone among the group snitched on us. The very next day, I was adopted. And as I said before I kept myself calm and cool, not screaming and demanding the reason for my sudden adoption. On the other hand my friends were glaring at me, unknowingly that it was someone else who set this up. Not a word can I say about my foster parents care, they were most hospitable. Will share about them in the next part of my story, stay tuned to know how I added the title "The Best teen Horse rider".
